

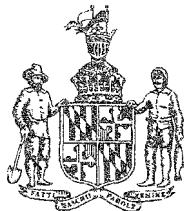

Dear Chairman Dingell, Representative Barton, Chairman Inouye and Senator Stevens:

I am serving my 16th year as a Delegate in the Maryland General Assembly and I also serve as the President of the National Caucus of Environmental Legislators. My colleagues and I encourage you to include Senator Diane Feinstein's amendment restricting the use of six toxic phthalates in children's toys in the reconciled version of the House/Senate Consumer Product Safety Commission Reform Act.


As you are aware, state legislatures in California and Washington have already acted to ban these toxic chemicals in our children's products, and Vermont and Minnesota legislators recently sent similar legislation to their Governors. This year, my colleagues in over a dozen states and I have introduced legislation targeting phthalates. As we continue our efforts to regulate harmful substances found in our children's toys and other products, we urge you to adopt the Feinstein Amendment in the conference committee so that all children can receive the same protection that is afforded to those in only a few states.

We are pleased this amendment contains a "savings clause" that would prevent the federal preemption of state efforts to regulate phthalates more strictly in toys and other product categories. We urge you to safeguard our ability as state legislators to act on emerging scientific evidence and protect the health of our citizens. It is important that states not be preempted from going beyond federal regulations.

As we continue the good work in states all across the country to protect our kids from harmful chemicals, it is reassuring to know that you and your colleagues have taken a leadership role on this issue. Too often, my colleagues serving in state legislatures find it a lonely battlefield when working on this and other environmental health issues. Your leadership is appreciated by my colleagues who share similar concerns for our children's health.

Please preserve the Feinstein Amendment prohibiting the use of phthalates in children's toys and childcare articles and its savings clause when the Conference Committee takes up the Consumer Product Safety Commission Reform Act. You will have our support and gratitude.
